

University of Cambridge scholarships for European students

Cambridge Trust scholarships for undergraduate students

The Cambridge Trust offers a small number of part-cost scholarships, usually up to £10,000 each, for students with Overseas fee status, including European students. Applicants must demonstrate both financial need and significant academic achievement and potential.

To apply for a Cambridge Trust scholarship, students will first need to receive an offer of admission from a Cambridge College via the standard undergraduate application process. Offer-holders will be invited by their College to complete a separate application to the Trust.

Cambridge College scholarships for undergraduate students

In addition to the part-cost scholarships offered by the Cambridge Trust, several Colleges offer scholarships for which European students are eligible. There is no separate application process for any of the opportunities listed below – students will be automatically considered if they select one of these Colleges on their UCAS application form and meet the relevant eligibility criteria.

Christ's College

The Christ's College International Awards are worth £10,000 per year and may be accompanied by a full or partial waiver of the College fee, which is currently £9,800 per year.

Gonville & Caius College

The Omorovicza Bursary is awarded by Gonville & Caius College to a student from Hungary. If there is no eligible student from Hungary, the bursary is awarded to a European student. The College may also provide additional financial support for European students who receive a part-cost scholarship from the Cambridge Trust.
