

Our EU Transition Scholarships support full-time undergraduate students who are commencing taught courses from August 2022.

UNDERGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIPS

- £5,000 per year for Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences courses
- £5,000 per year for Strathclyde Business School courses
- £8,000 per year for Faculty of Engineering courses
- £6,000 -£8,000 per year for Faculty of Science courses, depending on the subject area

ELIGIBILITY

The scholarship will be available to all EU applicants who would have previously been eligible for Home (Scottish/EU) fee status but, because of Brexit, will now be classified as being eligible for International fee status.

HOW TO APPLY

Eligible students will be identified through their application to study and will receive an email to inform them that they have been awarded the scholarship. Therefore, you do not need to make a separate application for this scholarship.

The scholarships will be automatically applied to:

EU nationals and their dependant family members who are self-funding and:

- are resident in the European Economic Area, Switzerland or the UK at the time of application; and
- are classed as international for tuition fee purposes; and
- are entering a full time degree undergraduate or postgraduate taught Masters programmes for the Academic year 2021/22 or 2022/23

This scholarship does not apply to students classified as Home or RUK for tuition fee purposes.
